ADMISSION POLICY

Admission to Ocean Global School is guided by a transparent and merit-based system designed to ensure fairness and academic readiness.

1. Admissions are granted based on the order of registration and the candidate's performance in the entrance assessment conducted by the school.

2. The child must be personally introduced to the Principal by the parent or guardian who will be accountable for the student's conduct and academic progress both within and beyond school premises.

3. A valid birth certificate issued by the competent municipal or government authority must be submitted at the time of admission. This document becomes part of the school's permanent records and will not be returned under any circumstance.

Aadhar Card copy must be submitted along with other documents.

4. A transfer certificate from the student's previous school is mandatory for all admissions beyond Kindergarten. Admission will be deemed provisional until the TC is verified.

5. In the case of students transferring from schools outside the state or country, the transfer certificate must be duly countersigned by the relevant educational authority.

6. The school reserves the right to deny admission if any required documentation is incomplete, falsified, or delayed without justification.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1.School Hours:

- School operates from 8 am
- The school gate closes sharply at 8 am Students must arrive before 7:55 am

2.Attendance and Punctuality:

- Punctual and regular attendance is compulsory.
- Leave of absence for attending marriages, functions, etc., must be applied in advance, even if it is for one day.
- A specific reason for absence is mandatory. Students must bring a note of excuse from a parent or guardian upon returning and must be recorded in the designated space in the school calendar.
- Absences exceeding three days require notification to the principal.
- If a student attending the morning session requires leave in the afternoon, prior permission from the principal or section head is needed.

3.Classroom Conduct:

- A warning bell rings 10 minutes before the start of class.
- At the first bell before each session, students should go in silence to their respective classes and wait for the teacher.
- Students should not arrive early unless for approved reasons, in which case they must proceed directly to their classroom and study.
- Smoking, liquor, and drug consumption are strictly prohibited. Anyone found violating this rule will face strict disciplinary action including possible legal consequences.
- Personal property should be marked with the owner's name and unclaimed items should be brought to the principal's office.
- Mobile phones, tablets, and electronic gadgets are prohibited; if found, this will be confiscated and strict disciplinary action will be taken, as this is a serious violation of school rules.
- Students should not wear any gold ornaments (except for the small ear rings to school).
- Students must greet staff members on meeting them for the first time each day.

4.Classroom Etiquette:

- Students cannot leave the classroom without the teacher's permission or until the class is dismissed.

- At the closing bell of each session, students must leave the classroom only after the teacher has left.
- Movement between classrooms at the end of each period should be quick and silent.

5.Possessions:

- Students should not bring undue amounts of money, gold ornaments, or fancy watches to school.

6. Uniform and Appearance:

- Students must wear the prescribed uniform.
- Proper haircuts and clipped nails are required. Girls with short hair must wear a black hair band; shoulder-length hair must be in two ponytails, and longer hair must be in two braids with black clips, hairbands, or ribbons only.
- Black sandals are allowed during monsoon season; otherwise, black shoes and school socks are mandatory from September 15 onwards.
- Fancy shoes are not permitted and will result in fines.
- Violation of any rules will result in charging the fine.

7.Conduct and Discipline:

- Irregular attendance, insubordination, habitual inattention to schoolwork, stealing, fighting, obscenity, etc., can result in temporary or permanent dismissal.
- Other offenses such as tardiness and damaging school property are punishable. Serious offenses will be punished according to the gravity of the same.
- While the school is not responsible for student conduct outside its premises, it will take action for serious misconduct committed outside its grounds if substantiated.
- If any student or parent is involved in any serious offense, the school will take strict action, which may even lead to suspension.

8.Parental Involvement:

- Parents are not permitted to disturb their child during class hours.
- In emergencies, parents must inform the school office or section head to meet or take their child.

9.Language Policy:

- English is the medium of communication within the school premises. Speaking in any other language will incur a fine of Rs. 100.

POLICIES AND PRACTICES

1.Discipline Policy:

- Students will be closely monitored for adherence to school rules.
- Consistent violations may result in suspension or, depending on severity, expulsion.
- A discipline committee, consisting of the chairperson, principal, Section Head and teacher representatives, handle all discipline matters. Their decisions are final.
- Immediate penalties include being debarred from exams for cheating and losing marks for late project submissions.

2.Remedial Classes:

- Remedial classes are scheduled from 02:00 PM to 02: 40PM daily for students needing extra academic attention.

3.Counselling and Special Education:

- The school has appointed a Student counsellor to address student and parent welfare concerns, maintaining confidentiality.
- They collaborate with counsellors, occupational therapists, psychologists, and parents to support students' development and socialization.

FEES

- School encourages digital payment.
- Annual Tuition Fee is payable in two installments - 1st Instalment on or before April 10th 2026, 2nd Instalment on or before September 10th 2026.
- Parents who fail to pay the fee by the prescribed date will incur a penalty of 50 rupees per day after a 30-day grace period. After 30 days, the penalty increases to 100 rupees per day for the next 15 days. If the fees remain unpaid after this period, students will not be permitted to attend classes.
- Parents opting for monthly fee payments must submit a formal request letter for approval. Upon approval they are required to provide post-dated checks (PDC) before the 5th of every month. Failing to do so will incur a charge of 100 rupees per day for 15 days. After this period, the student will not be permitted to enter the class. In case of check bounces, a penalty of 500 rupees will be imposed.
- Transportation fees need to be paid in three installments in advance: the first installment should be paid on May 5th, the second on August 5th, and the third on November 5th. Any parent who fails to pay on the above-mentioned dates will have their transport facility stopped. There is no deduction in transport fees for holidays within that month. Parents opting for monthly payment of transportation fee, must submit a formal request letter for approval.
- The students who are opting for mess regularly are expected to pay the mess fees in advance for three months. Those who are taking the mess irregularly need to pay the amount by the end of every month. Failing to do so will result in canteen food not being provided.
- Parents opting for monthly payments should provide post-dated cheques (PDC) before the 5th of every month. Failing to do so will incur a charge of Rs. 100 per day for 15 days. After this period, the student will not be permitted to enter the class. In case a cheque bounces, a penalty of Rs. 500 attend will be imposed.
- Defaulters are not eligible to attempt the examination.
- In case of any discontinuation, no refund or adjustment against the fee will be entertained

BUS RULES

We provide transport services for all students from PreKG to Class VII, ensuring a safe journey to and from school. Bus seats are allocated based on availability. For any queries regarding school transportation, parents are encouraged to contact the school transport manager

- Students must strictly adhere to the scheduled bus timings provided on the first day of school. Students should wait at the pick-up spot 5 minutes prior to the given time. The school bus will not wait for students, even for a minute. If a student misses the school bus, the school is not responsible for this. Due to any unavoidable reasons, in case the bus is delayed by a few minutes, we kindly ask for your cooperation.
- If a child misses the bus, parents must take them to the next pickup point for boarding. The driver cannot return to the original stop.
- According to the Educational Department and RTO regulations, changes in the pickup and drop-off spots are not allowed. Parents who need to change the pickup or drop-off spot must visit the school to meet with the PRO or Transport Manager and complete the necessary formalities. Approval depends on seat availability, and a fee of Rs. 250 will be charged.
- The school is not responsible for any transactions between parents and the driver, attender.
- Parents must inform the school office or section heads about any changes in residential address or telephone numbers.

School Bus Rules and Conduct Guidelines

- Always maintain proper discipline to avoid distracting the driver's attention.
- Adhere strictly to the seating arrangements assigned by the bus leaders or accompanying teachers.
- Cooperate courteously with the bus attendants at all times.
- Never attempt to board or alight from a moving bus; such actions are extremely dangerous.
- Refrain from pushing or crowding while boarding or getting off the bus.
- Do not stand directly in front of or behind the bus at any time.
- Do not discard any objects inside the bus or throw them out of the windows.
- Approach the bus entry door only after the bus has come to a complete stop.
- Occupy the nearest available seat immediately after boarding.
- Use only English as the medium of conversation while on the school bus. Violators will be fined.
- Any violation of bus conduct rules may lead to suspension from bus services for a minimum of one week, depending on the seriousness of the offence.
- Eating or consuming food on the bus is strictly prohibited. Offenders will be subject to disciplinary action.

Library Rules

- Books will be issued once a week, according to the class schedule.
- Students must return books within 7 days; they can be reissued for an additional 7 days if needed.
- Reissuing books requires bringing them back to school.
- Books are issued to the borrower only.
- Students must take good care of library books and report any damage immediately.
- New books will not be issued until previous ones are returned.
- If a book is lost, the borrower must pay double the cost.
- All library books must be returned before term 1 and term 2 exams.

TO PARENTS AND GUARDIAN

1. Parents and guardians are expected to support the school authorities by promoting discipline and regularity at home. Students should dedicate three to four hours daily to personal studies, and more time should be devoted to studies on holidays. Lack of insistence on regular attendance and home studies by parents may lead to disappointing results.
2. Parents should help students create a timetable for all activities on weekdays and weekends.
3. Parents and guardians are encouraged to meet with the principal, with a prior appointment, between 2.30 pm and 3:30 pm to discuss the student's conduct and progress. Similarly, parents should schedule appointments to meet with teachers to discuss their child's progress and behaviour.
4. Parents and guardians are not permitted to enter classrooms during school hours, except on the designated open house day.
5. Parents must review their children's progress records and assist in addressing any academic or behavioural shortcomings.
6. As members of the Parent-Teacher Association, parents and guardians should foster a close relationship and mutual understanding between home and school. They are strongly encouraged to attend parent-teacher meetings, sports day, school day, general body meetings, and other school functions.
7. Attendance at tests and exams is compulsory. In cases of illness, the principal must be informed immediately. Students caught cheating during tests or exams will be issued a Transfer Certificate (TC) at any point in the academic year.
8. A student who fails twice in the same class may lose their seat in the school. With the willing cooperation of parents and guardians, the school aims to mould students into good, God-fearing citizens.
9. Parents and guardians are expected to maintain proper conduct in speech and actions when communicating with school authorities. Misbehaviour towards school authorities will result in a notice to cease all relations with the school immediately.

10. In case of any kind of abuse or any other issue occurring on school premises, it should be immediately reported in writing to the Student Welfare Committee. This committee includes the chairman, principal, section heads, counsellor and in-charge teachers. It is important that all individuals—students, staff, and parents—maintain a safe distance from each other. Violating this directive may result in strict action by the school authorities.
